IF YOU REQUIRE SPECIAL ASSISTANCE please let the scheduler know. Drivers are allowed to help senior citizens and disabled passengers with groceries but cannot lift over 20 pounds at one time. The driver is not allowed to handle money, pick up prescriptions or mail for any passenger.

TO CANCEL YOUR TRIP please call the scheduler at least **30 minutes** prior to your pick-up time if you live in town and no longer need a ride or **1 hour** prior to pick-up time if you live out of town.

BUSES will not attempt roadways that will damage or cause them to become stuck in snow or mud. Driveways must have enough room for the buses to turn around and be clear of overhanging branches.
